

Advancing Futures Bursary

The Advancing Futures Bursary is being offered to former youth in care and/or youth on extensions of care who are attending post secondary education on a full or part time basis. This bursary, coordinated through the Building Futures program, is intended to assist individuals with education costs to support their training and employment pathway.

Bursaries will be awarded on demonstrated financial need up to a maximum of \$10,000 based on course load.

Am I Eligible?

Participants must meet all the following criteria to be eligible for the Advancing Futures Bursary:

- A resident of Manitoba between the ages of 18-30
- A Youth in Care or Former Youth in Care in one of the following areas:
 - A youth in care on an extension of care
 - A former youth in care in receipt of a tuition waiver
 - A former youth in care funding your academic pursuits
- Enrolled Full time (according to the institution) or Part-Time at an eligible post-secondary educational institution for the current year. *(please note: Bursaries will be evaluated based course load and hours)*

How to Apply

- Complete the attached application form
- Provide a **cover letter** telling the selection committee a little bit about you and why you chose your current post secondary program and your aspirations for the future (2 page maximum, where directed in the application)
- Include a copy of current transcript (scanned and emailed to ITESinfo@gov.mb.ca or mailed to ITES address below)
- Complete the attached consent form to verify school registration and youth in care status with the Department of Families or Child Welfare Authority

What is Building Futures?

Building Futures provides employment and training assistance services to youth in care or aging out of care to ease the transition to adult life. Services include education planning and/or job search, help finding secure housing, budgeting and money management training and life guidance and support.

Who is Eligible for Services?

- Youth in Care, youth on an Extension of Care or youth formally in care with one of the following Authorities:
 - General Authority
 - Metis Child and Family Services Authority
 - Southern Authority
 - Northern Authority
 - Between the ages of 16 – 30

Youth Service Navigation

can help you figure out the right path to help you achieve your goals as an adult.

Building Futures Counseling

is a free service to support you with life, relationship or other important issues.

Tuition Waiver Coordinator

can help you with the Tuition Waiver process with each post-secondary institute.

Employment Facilitator

can help you develop an action plan to support you towards employment.

Financial Counseling

is offered one on one or through a variety of workshops including Budgeting and Financial Literacy
