Voices is currently seeking a vibrant, energetic, and friendly person to join our **Summer Outreach Team**. The Summer Outreach Team engages youth in and from care through activities that focus on their physical, emotional, and social development.

Reporting to the Program Coordinator, the Summer Outreach Team will work with staff and volunteers to ensure that programming goals are met. Assets include a fun and outgoing personality; education and/or experience planning and delivering programming for youth; knowledge of Manitoba's child welfare system; and experience working in cross-cultural settings. Priority will be given to alumni of care.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Applicants must be between the ages of 15-29

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Help plan and facilitate summer program activities, with support and guidance from the staff team
- Mentor participants through positive interactions, and by being a positive role model
- Assist in preparation and clean-up of activities
- Model healthy behaviour (debriefing, conflict resolution, etc)
- Respect confidentiality
- Assist in summer program evaluation
- Be punctual, attend daily, work as part of the team, and participate in all activities
- Fulfill any other duties as assigned
- A clear Criminal Record Check and Child Abuse Registry Check (will accept valid checks approved within the last 6 months)
