Voices: Manitoba's Youth in Care Network is a rights-based, youth-driven organization that engages, equips, and empowers youth in and from care, ages 12 to 30, through activities that focus on personal, emotional, and social development. We are under the stewardship of the Boys and Girls Clubs of Winnipeg.

The Voices Summer Outreach Worker is responsible for engaging youth in and from care by helping to plan and facilitate activities. As Summer Outreach Worker, you represent Voices: Manitoba's Youth in Care Network in the community, creating spaces where young people in and from care can participate in activities that help them to know and practice their rights while building healthy relationships.

You are creative, energetic, and fun. You have experience working with young people, and you are comfortable speaking in public and working with small groups of people. You have a heart for social justice, and you're willing to learn more about rights and advocacy from a youth in care perspective. You enjoy the energy that comes from working with a team, as much as you like those times when you work independently. You have lived experience of Manitoba's child welfare system. Most importantly though, you are excited to help young people in and from care recognize their limitless potential.

Job Description/Responsibilities:

- Help plan and facilitate activities, including rights and advocacy workshops
- Be a positive role-model
- Represent Voices in the community
- Follow-up with participants after events, meetings, activities

Experience/Qualifications:

- This is an Urban Green Team position, so you must be **between the ages of 15-29**.
- You have lived experience in Manitoba's child welfare system (group homes, foster homes, kinship care, adoption, independent living programs)
- You are comfortable working with and learning from people from different cultural backgrounds
- You understand how to work with computer programs like MS Office (Word, Excel, Publisher), email, social media, and ZOOM
- You can provide a clear Criminal Record Check and Child Abuse Registry Check to employment (valid within 6 months)
